## JANE BOSWELL OBITUARY

**J**ane Sherer Boswell Sept. 12, 1946 - Sept. 28, 2022 Jane Sherer Boswell passed away peacefully at her home on September 28, 2022, after a yearlong battle with lung cancer at age 76.
